 - a. Chair Danuta Wang welcomed everyone to the meeting, introduced James Roe as the Vice Chair, and expressed that she is looking forward to the Club Fair.
 - b. Vice Chair James Roe had no report.

 - d. Advisors
 - i. Aaron Schaefer, Student Life and Leadership Manager, was not present.
 - ii. Fauzi Hamadeh, Student Life and Leadership Assistant, reported that the Club Officer Orientation Workshops had been well attended. He also reminded clubs that each group's president and treasurer must attend a workshop session.
- VII. Unfinished Action, Discussion, and Information Items**
 - a. Fall 2014 Club Fair and Task Force – Chair Wang and Advisor Hamadeh**

Mr. Hamadeh announced that he would be sending out an email with a link for the clubs to sign-up to participate in the Club Fair. Clubs will have until the end of business on Monday, September 29 to sign-up. During the fair, students will have to visit at least three clubs and get a passport signed in order to receive free pizza. Mr. Hamadeh also announced that the Student Life Prep Room would be available for clubs to make banners. In addition, Mr. Hamadeh requested that any photocopying requests be submitted to the Center for Student Life no later than Monday.

VIII. New Business, Discussion, and Information Items

a. Annual Dance Concert – Performance Dance Ensemble

PDE presented a request for funding to support the group's annual Fall Dance Concert. The concert will be held Friday, December 5, 2014 in the CSM Theatre. Performers will be from PDE as well as the College's Dance classes. The group is also going to be inviting performers from Cañada and Skyline Colleges, as well as from some local dance studios.

Motion to approve \$1,750.00 to support the PDE Fall Dance Concert by the Media Club; seconded by the Botany Club.

With a vote of 24 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining, the ICC recommended to the ASCSM Senate that this funding request be approved.

b. Phi Theta Kappa International Convention – Phi Theta Kappa Beta Xi Eta Chapter

PTK presented a request for funding to support the group's attendance at the PTK International Convention in Spring 2015. The conference, which will take place in San Antonio, Texas, provides an opportunity for local PTK chapters to present their on-campus activities, such as the Honors in Action Project and the College Project. The funding that PTK is requested will help defray some of the costs of airfare, registration, food, and lodging.

Motion to approve \$2,5000.00 to support PTK attendance at the PTK International Conference by PDE; seconded by Media Club.

Mr. Hamadeh asked if the funds that PTK is requesting will cover the entire cost of attending the conference. PTK stated that the total cost of the trip is between \$6,000 and \$7,000. The difference would be made up with funding that the group receives from the CSM President's Office.

With a vote of 24 in favor, 0 abstaining, and 0 opposed, the ICC recommended to the ASCSM Senate that this funding request be approved.
