Motion to recommend approval of \$2,500.00 to partially cover the costs of a trip to Washington, DC to attend the Active Minds National Conference by Umoja Club; seconded by Transfer Club. By a vote of 11 in favor, 1 oppose, and 0 abstaining, the motion carried.

REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO ATTEND ACTIVE MINDS NATIONAL CONFERENCE

Motion to recommend approval of an additional \$1,000.00 to Active Minds to partially cover the costs of a trip to Washington, DC to attend the Active Minds National Conference by Transfer Club; seconded by Alpha Gamma Sigma. By a vote of 10 in favor, 2 oppose, and 0 abstaining, the motion carried.

FUNDING FOR SOUTHEAST ASIA CULTURE CLUB WELCOME PARTY

Motion to recommend approval of \$400.00 to Southeast Asia Culture Club to fund a “welcome back!” event for students with food and snacks by Nepalese Student Association; seconded by Active Minds Club. By a vote of 12 in favor, 0 oppose, and 0 abstaining, the motion carried.
