### Open agenda items:

### **GE Handbook – last reading and voting for acceptance**

Teresa reviewed the information that was changed on the draft GE handbook. Ken suggested adding a note explaining the numbering of the GE areas, specifically why Area E3 is missing. Based on that suggestion, Teresa added Area E3 back to the list but included the text, "Suspended Effective Fall 2010."

Committee members also requested that the ending punctuation on SLOs and formatting be standardized on all the SLO listings.

Many changes were made in the Career Exploration and Self-Development area. Teresa asked members to review the SLOs under this area. Interim VP, Dilley suggested changing SLO #1 Describe career opportunities and their attendant educational requirements and professional responsibilities. Options were discussed, such as describe career paths..., describe career options... and describe various careers... a vote was taken and the second option was chosen.

The text listed under Procedure – Recommending a course for General Education Area fulfillment at CSM, "If a course which is currently part of the College of San Mateo GE pattern is being revised, any major revision should be reviewed for adherence to assigned GE area(s)" was reviewed. Discussion ensued regarding what a major revision consists of and when the course modification should be reviewed by COI to ensure the course still meets the requirements for the GE area. Additionally, Anne Stafford brought up the concern about whose responsibility it should be to determine if a modified course still meets the GE area, faculty or the committee. Teresa decided to remove the text for the time being, but asked the committee to think about this topic for a future handbook revision.

Teresa also reviewed the appendices and guidelines for information competency.

With the proposed edits above, a vote was taken to accept the revised GE Handbook. The motion was moved, seconded and carried unanimously.

## Follow-up on District Curriculum Committee meeting regarding checklist items

Teresa asked the chairs from Skyline and Canada to poll their committees about what they would like presented for the checklist areas under Representative Methods of Evaluation and Representative Instructional Methods. In the meantime, Teresa will be sending out a Google document to survey the committee on the redundancy of checklist items. At a future meeting, Teresa will take the results back to District Curriculum Committee for further discussion and resolution.
