## • Open Agenda

- Memo: Addition of a Local Associate Degree GE Pattern Option postponed
- Memo: Aligning General Education Course Options for the Local Associate Degree with CSU GE Course Options

There was a discussion on the proposal to align GE course options for the local associate degree with CSU GE options. Marsha Ramezane, Articulation Officer, explained that in cases where CSUs approved courses for their CSU GE areas, it seems logical to have those courses listed in the same areas as our local GEs. (See attached memo.) An example is PSYC 105 which was approved for CSU Life Science but does not show up in the CSM Natural Science area. If the memo is approved, PSYC 105 will appear in the Natural Science area for Fall 2017. Changes would be helpful to students planning to transfer or applying for an AA degree.

A member requested that the Articulation Officer verify a match between the proposed courses' local GE placement SLOs and the CSU GE placement. Marsha willingly agreed to review the courses for matches. COI members can check the GE patterns for courses that are being updated to match the GE areas. Currently, there is no process for looking back at GE placements for courses that have been updated.

Going forward, the Articulation Officer will provide an annual GE alignment memo at the COI meeting in May. A few changes including typo corrections are needed prior to a vote on the memo. It will return as an action item at the next meeting. There will be another memo at the meeting in May with new courses or other changes.

There have been conversations about modifying the local GE pattern to align with Title 5.
