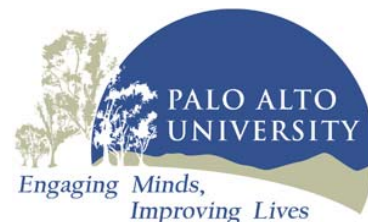

Palo Alto University Transfer Agreement 2011-2012 Catalog Requirements



Transfer students must successfully complete 90 quarter (60 semester) transferable units with a minimum 2.0 GPA* to be considered for admission to Palo Alto University. Only courses with a grade of C or better will be accepted, though all transferable courses taken will count toward GPA calculation. Students at Palo Alto University are required to complete 90 additional quarter unit hours (*totaling 180 quarter units*) in order to obtain the Bachelor of Science degree.

Transfer students must complete either the California State University General Education/Breadth (CSU GE Breadth) or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC for CSU) with grades of C or better in each course. Either pattern satisfies PAU's general education requirements.
