Overview of Classified senate presentation:

How do we ensure we are connect with adjunct faculty

AB705 updates:

- All community college students who are entering CC for first time are being placed into transfer level courses.
- How do we offer support to the students who would not normally be placed into this transfer level?
- ESL has a longer timeline
- Fall 2019 is when this needs to be implemented in full
- Funding formula for colleges: tied into completion rates for first year of math and English
- English 105, 5 unit class with additional support
- 838- not sure what to do with this course (students can only self-select this course)
- English 105 is meeting the needs to students who may have placed in below level English courses

Math has implemented:

- Pre-algebra and algebra course was removed from schedule
 - Math 120 and Math 190 w/ or without support
- 7 or 9 sections of 120
- 2 sections of math 190 (**15 students in support class**)
- No one can be placed into non-transferrable courses (fall 2019)
- Bridge program in summer and connected to Year one Promise (possibly)
