***Consider Design Principles identified by GP Team: Balance, Time, Consistency, Integrated, Student Accessible, Intuitive***

    - Considerations of student readiness.
      - Difficulty rating of courses to help guide students.
      - What courses go good together
      - We need the counselors- we need the human element
    - We need to consider all elective classes. The elective classes that were on our cards we a part of this (1-6 units). Should include an electives or other interests areas.
    - Balance came into play a lot during this activity. You need the human element to discuss these things.
    - We do have to have something to start with though- this is an example
    - Counselors:
      - Kristi- this is really specific to each student. She has great appreciate for our counselors
      - Talk about pairings of classes as we schedule classes. As we map this out we can look at course taking patterns and look at scheduling this way. This is happening on micro-levels.
      - Gather data around what is working with data
      - Consider backwards mapping
        - Ensure that if we study this that we need to consider the nuances that occurs
        - What should we do next:
        - Can we consolidate our 3 pathways into one pathway
        - Document these steps→ so we can share with other groups
        - Can we do this with a larger group? Stagger at division meetings
        - How can we use this same process for the rest of our colleagues

- Also include the questions that it has raised – put these in priority order
- How do we inform how we set up our processes?
- We want to make these forms (core requirements and IGETC more palatable) This is **framework**.
  - Maybe 5 most common starting points but we cannot make just one plan.
- Maps will clarify course patterns and offerings
- CLP team:
  - When should we invite them in our process?
    - How do we get this piece to the outside. We need to learn about formatting and how it is logistically carried out.
    - Were do the ripples start to go out. Logistically specific.
  - What CLP to show us the nuts and the bolts of the logistics to the team and campus.
  - March 6<sup>th</sup>- revisit this idea
    - How do we get CLP to help us?
    - What is the steering committees next steps?
      - Consolidate our 3 maps
    - Lets do part time maps and one other student situation
      - Then we ask CLP- are we on the right track?
    - Need to make summer plans
    - LFM plans- what do we want the team to do?

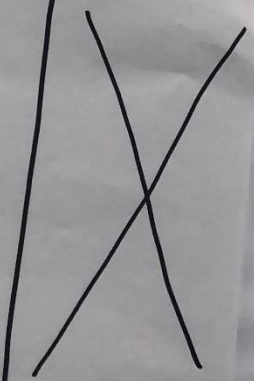
