- IV. Review and Approve Updated Equity Director Job Description Henry shared that President Claire is interested in discussing the position being a Dean position. The position may include the oversight of student support services and/or other areas. The college is adding another new position: director of DSPS. Discussion followed about the implications of having the Equity position be at the Dean level.

Regarding the job description: Lee suggested combining #6 with another responsibility, committee agreed to combine with #11. Justine asked that the cultural competency qualification be evidenced in a concrete way, discussion followed. Committee agreed to require supplemental questions as part of the application process, to get evidence around cultural competency, and personal and professional experiences.

- Diversity Planning Committee Update Sylvia reported \$7600 has been approved;
 \$3,836.45 is remaining for the year. The money can carry over until December 2015. Survey results are being collected and will be analyzed for themes and additional opportunities. Requests can be made for next fall from the current year funds. Makiko reported that the Doodu Boy Play by Stefhen Bryan was very successful. About 200 students came. Henry will be submitting an event with Dr Ronnie Sanlo. Krystal facilitated a discussion at The Village about language and culture called "The 'N' Word and the Power of Language".
- VI. Debrief of National Equity Project Flex Day Event Theresa reported that the event was successful. Participants gained insights into one another's identities and the power of communicating across differences. Committee members spoke about their experiences at the workshop. The comments were mostly positive. Some attendees felt more content and less use of the didactic approach would be useful. Pacific Educational Group.com was suggested as educational equity group that does summits called courageous conversations. Lorena recommends them for a workshop next year. BSI, CAE and SEP are collaborating on bringing more presentations to the campus.
