Myth: Everything is available for Free on the Internet

TRUTH:

- Only 30% of the medical literature is freely available on the Web or less than one-quarter of the medical and biomedical journals are freely available.
- Only 60% of the article content published since 1992 is available electronically.

TRUTH:


There is an overwhelming amount of information on the Internet, but people need information training and skills to understand what constitutes valid information.


