Student Assistants: Because the CCCAA (the governing body that oversees intercollegiate athletics) has legislated mandatory statistical record keeping, we need to have an increase in our student-assistant budget. Currently, we are allocated \$2,000 but will need \$6,000 (\$2,000 each for baseball, softball, basketball). In FY 16/17, we will need to increase it to include an additional \$2,000 for volleyball.

4.3.3 CCCAAsports.org is the official website for collecting schedules, rosters, results, and statistics for all team sports sponsored by the CCCAA as defined in Bylaw 3.7. All California community colleges fielding athletic teams are required to update information on this website in a timely manner. Required timelines for inputting schedule information onto the statewide statistical website are: August 15 for fall sport schedules, October 20 for basketball, and January 15 for spring sports. Additionally, numerical rosters must be posted at least one (1) day prior to the first game, and results with complete and accurate individual statistics must be posted in accordance with sport specific guidelines, but not later than two (2) working days after the completion of the contest or tournament.
