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### **Resources Requested (Non-Duplicates with Individual Program Reviews)**

Classified Staff: Increase 48% Athletic Trainer position to 100% for safety of our student athletes as well as ensuring all athletic contests are covered by a trainer, as mandated by the CCCAA Constitution by which we are governed. Currently, 1.5 positions are not sufficient enough to cover all home contests, i.e. we could be hosting a baseball game, softball game, track meet and swim meet all on the same day.

Student Assistants: Recently mandated by the CCCAA is reporting of statistics to a state-wide database. Failure to do so could result in elimination of post-season, or in the very least, suspension of coaches from contests. Each sport requires at least \$2,000 in student-assistant money to provide these services (baseball, softball, basketball, football). All other sports have a system-wide reporting database managed by game-day administration. Total for each season (year) for all sports would be \$8,000.
