1. Overall, how would you rate the quality of the MRC services you received?

5. Were you able to get help when you needed it in the MRC?

- Maybe have professors bring student down to the math lab for a 5-10 minute meeting about what the math lab is and how it can benefit us. None of my classes this past year took out class down there, I just kind of found it on my way to class once.
- I've used the MRC multiple times. I've taken Precalc, Statistics, and now Calc 1 so I'm no stranger to the MRC. Hiring processes need to be seriously reevaluated because there is no quality in tutors.
