Deadline for submission of applications is <u>Thursday, March 12, 2015,</u> <u>12 noon</u> to Karen Chadwick, Financial Aid Office.

Selection for interviews will be based on financial need, acceptance at a fouryear college, and other financial support (e.g., grants, other scholarships, savings).

Rotarians will review all applications and tax returns, and letters will be mailed to students regarding their status. A list of the students accepted or rejected will be mailed to advisors. Students accepted for interviews will be contacted by a Rotarian to set up an in-home interview, with a parent or guardian present, if the student is 18 or under. Final interviews with the Rotary panel will be held on April 21st and 22nd after 4 pm in the San Mateo City Hall. The Rotary Awards Luncheon will be held on May 7th.
