- Must be attending one of the community colleges in the County.
- Must have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4. Scale.
- Must plan on attending a 4-year public or private college or university.
- Must plan to enroll in a teacher preparation program.
- Must submit a 350-500 word essay stating his/her need for the scholarship and goals and ambitions.
- A minimum of 2 letters of recommendations (from instructors, activity supervisors or persons known to the candidate) and a copy of current GPA must be submitted with the application.

**2018 Fall/Quarter Semester:** First Installment Scholarship Payment

**Requirement:** The following documents must be submitted before payment is made:

- Letter of Acceptance from the 4 year college/university of your choice
- Proof of registration at the 4 year college/university
- Verification of course load of at least 9 units per semester or equivalent
- Grade report of past semester/quarter

**2019 Second Quarter/Spring Semester:** Second Installment Scholarship Payment

**Requirement:** The following documents must be submitted before payment is made:

- Verification of college/university continuation of studies
- Verification of course load of at least 9 units per semester or equivalent
- Grade report of past semester/quarter
