•Must have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4. Scale.

•Must plan on attending a 4-year public or private college or university.

•Must plan to enroll in a teacher preparation program.

•Must submit a 350-500 word essay stating his/her need for the scholarship and goals and ambitions.

• A minimum of 2 letters of recommendations (from instructors, activity supervisors or persons known to the candidate) and a copy of current GPA must be submitted with the application.
