1. Online Degree Application and Student Self-Assessment Survey

Most of the meeting was a presentation of the online degree application and student self-assessment survey. For the survey, students will be asked to “Strongly Agree”, “Agree”, “Disagree”, or “Strongly Disagree” with a statement of the Degree SLO or part of the Degree SLO.

Implementation is planned for having the Degree Application and Survey in place this semester and developed in the Fall for Certificates.

The Music Degree SLOs seem to be in error. These will be checked on. There was a question/comment that the instructions for self-assessment may make students biased to “Strongly Agree”. This should be avoided.
