Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) training

Presenter: Sharon Bartels

Sharon showed a video and demonstrated the application of an AED.

An AED is a devise that analyzes the heart's electrical rhythm and is used to deliver a shock to a person suffering from sudden cardiac arrest. With an AED a person's survival rate from cardiac arrest increases by 20%. The device comes with recorded instructions and full illustrations. AEDs are used in conjunction with CPR.
