## Nursing

### Overview

College of San Mateo's Nursing Program provides students with opportunities for learning at the College, local hospitals, and community health agencies. The program is fully accredited by the California Board of Registered Nursing. Upon graduation, the candidate receives an Associate in Science degree in Nursing, and is eligible to take the National Council Licensing Exam (NCLEX) examination. The graduate is also eligible to transfer to programs offering a bachelor's degree in nursing.

#### \*\*NEW REGENCY REQUIREMENT\*\*

Beginning with the admissions cycle in Spring of 2020, all Biology courses (Anatomy, Physiology and Microbiology) must have been completed with a grade of C or higher within the past **FIVE** years. All Biology courses have to be complete no later than **January 1, 2015**. Any courses completed prior to January 2015 will not be considered. This **DOES NOT** include the prerequisite courses.
