Dear CSM faculty members,

We are pleased to announce the launch of a 5-week online course called *Principles of Online Teaching*, open to both adjunct and full-time faculty. The Instructional Deans and the VPI will select 12 participants from those that submit the attached application form. Preference or priority will be given to those instructors that plan to teach online in 2020 and the course has or will have an approved DE Addendum.

If accepted into *Principles of Online Teaching*, you will receive compensation to participate fully in a five-week online course beginning **Monday, June 10th**, in which you will spend at least 4 hours each week completing all activities by their due dates. In order to receive a certificate of completion, you must complete at least 80% of one hybrid or online course. Completion means that you are implementing the OEI Rubric to design and deliver your course in Canvas.

Faculty compensation will be as follows:

- 20 hours at your special rate to complete the 5-week online course
- 4 hours at your special rate upon delivery of at least 80% of one hybrid or online course

How to apply:

1. Please complete the *Section One: Faculty Application* portion of the form, including courses

to be taught online, and submit directly to your Dean (your Dean will fill out the *Section Two: Dean's Recommendation of Applicant* section of the form).

2. Submit the form to your Dean no later than **Friday, March 1st**, and please **do not copy Paul and Erica** as we are not involved in the selection process.
