First Week Tips

Visitor Parking

Visitors to campus may park free for the first 40 minutes in visitor parking areas in Marie Curie Lot 5, Forum Lot 8, and Olympian Lot 12. Visitors must purchase a daily permit (\$3 per day) for time beyond 40 minutes at the permit machines located in the lots (indicated by **V** on the map). Permits must be displayed face-up on the dashboard. No student parking allowed in visitor lots.



Important Dates

- Wednesday, Aug. 15 Fall Semester Begins
- Tuesday, Aug. 28 End of Add/Drop Period
 - Last day to add classes using authorization codes on WebSMART
 - Last day to drop a semester-long class with eligibility for fee credit or partial refund
- Wednesday, Aug. 29
 - Parking permit requirement begins for student lots
- Monday, Sept. 3 Labor Day Holiday No Classes
 - Last day to declare pass/no pass for semester-length courses
 - Semester-length courses dropped on or before this date will not appear on student's record
 - See WebSMART for deadlines for short courses
- Wednesday, Oct. 10 Flex Day No Classes
- Wednesday, Nov. 14 Last day to officially withdraw from a semesterlength class with assurance of a "W" grade

- Login to your @my.smccd.edu email account.
 - Can forward messages from this account to another address by going to the Gear menu > Settings > Forwarding and POP/IMAP and selecting "Forward a copy of incoming mail to..."
- Food service, coffee, and snacks are available in College Center (Building 10) and the Health & Wellness Building (Building 5).
- Student Lounges are located in Building 14, Building 16, and Building 12.
- Smoking is allowed in parking lots only. There is no smoking allowed in Socrates (Lot 4). This also applies to electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes) and vaping.



Parking Tips

- Students may park in all student lots without a permit for the first two weeks of classes.
 - Citations will start being issued in student lots on Wednesday, August 29, 2018.
- Parking permits may be purchased:
 - Online via WebSMART; delivered by mail within 3 5 business days
 - On campus at the Cashier's Office purchase station (Building 10, Room 360)
- Citations will be issued at all times for students parking in staff lots, visitor lots, red zones, and handicapped spaces.
