New Faculty Institute

CSM PD coordinators led a semester-long New Faculty Institute for the 11 new full-time, tenure track faculty members across nine disciplines. In the NFI, new faculty learned more about the tenure evaluation process, policies and procedures, the curriculum process, equity, crafting an educational philosophy, various initiatives on campus, and shared governance. The time together also was spent building an interdisciplinary community on campus for new faculty. During the spring semester, new faculty were strongly encouraged to participate in the E3T2S training that was facilitated by the Director of Equity at CSM.

Instructional Technology and Distance Education

The CSM Instructional Technology office led a series of workshops to support faculty using instructional technology and/or teaching online and hybrid courses.

- CSM: Accessibility and Universal Design Advocate Workshop (Cohort 1)
 - Hybrid Design with meetings and activities that spanned from Summer 2018 through Spring 2019
 - o Each faculty participant is compensated for 48 hours at their special rate
- CSM: Quality Online Teaching and Learning (Cohort)
 - o Fully Online from June 10, 2019 to July 14, 2019 (5-Week Course)
 - o Each faculty participant is compensated for 24 hours at their special rate

Educational Equity "Train the Trainer" Series

The College offers a comprehensive "train the trainer" series on student equity every spring. The goal of the workshop is to facilitate spreading educational equity campus-wide by providing training to participants who in turn, function as equity resource officers for their respective departments and divisions. The semester-long series is an intentional sequence of experiences designed to equip participants with a theoretical foundation and with concomitant practical skills.
