PLANNING PROCESS

1. EMP Planning Goals

Engage the CSM campus in a participatory process to define our Education Master Plan that considers data, the district goals, and a SWOT Analysis from constituents across campus. The qualitative data collected from the EMP focus group sessions will be validated at IPC through town hall meetings and interdisciplinary meetings. Once the qualitative data and 5in5 goals are defined, inter-division teams will implement the goals that will be monitored regularly.

 - o 5 in 5: Identify five focus areas that support our strategic goals over the next 5 years

- Fall Semester: Validate EMP Focus Group Qualitative data and 5in5 focus areas
- November-January: Draft EMP
- February: Draft EMP to IPC for review
- March: Draft EMP to campus for review
- April: EMP final approval

These draft focus areas directly support CSM's strategic Goals. Over the summer, an IPC workgroup (Madedeine, Mary, Heeju, Fauzi, Alicia, and Colby) will formalize the Focus Areas and define 3 priorities for each. They will be presented at IPC in the fall.
