The District Joint VP Council provides overall coordination in the planning, development and implementation of the instructional and student services programs of the District. The Council is consisted of the Vice Presidents at the three colleges and is co-chaired by the Deputy Chancellor and Vice Chancellor of Educational Services and Planning.
