FLEXIBLE	Seen as compliance-driven; lack of flexibility to target all student-learning concerns
TRACKABLE	Software: TracDat
PARTICIPATORY	All faculty are expected to participate and have access to assessment data
MEANINGFUL	Lack of meaningful outcomes & cross- campus conversations/collaboration

CSM's SLO Assessment 2018-Present









FLEXIBLE	Flexibiity to target salient student-learning concerns
TRACKABLE	Documented through Program Review, .pdf files, lack of data analysis
PARTICIPATORY	Only one faculty member required to report assessment through Program Review for whole program
MEANINGFUL	Meaningful outcomes in programs that embraced the new model; opportunities for cross-campus collaboration

OPTION: 1

DEFAULT

Course-level SLO Assessment

- Programs submit an assessment calendar, deciding what SLOs are assessed and when (3-year cycle?)
- Faculty members upload SLO assessment results from individual courses on an annual basis
- Results are discussed in division meetings and Flex Days
- Reflection in Program Review discusses outcomes and informs future program planning

OPTION 2

OPT-IN

Faculty "Inquiry Project"

- Programs submit an application for an "inquiry project" to be peerreviewed and approved (CTL?)
- Programs track progress in Nuventive on an annual basis
- Results are discussed in division meetings and Flex Days
- Reflection in Program Review discusses outcomes and informs future program planning
