Based on last year, I fear we will not be given any notice if our budget has been cut. Also, my big concern is getting a heads up about cuts to plan appropriately. This is especially true with cuts to student employee budgets. Hiring has to take place in May for new fall hires. I don't want to hire new people then find out in May there is no budget for them and have to rescind a job offer. The same is true for current student employees, I don't want to finish up in May telling them they have a job or a certain number of hours (approximately) and then a few weeks before the fall semester starts, I have to let them go or say instead of 15 hours, I can only give you five. It's not fair to the students. If I'm not going to be able to rehire them or have to give them significantly less hours, I want to tell them at the end of April or start of May so they have a chance to look for other on campus jobs before they're filled. I understand cuts have to be made, but having no heads up until the last minute makes it hard to plan out next year especially when student's jobs are involved.
