# Proposed Goals for Discussion & Vote

### 1. AI (Policy & Workload)

- Review of College Policy <u>"Guidelines Addressing Cheating and Plagiarism"</u>
- Establish Senate committee/workgroup to tackle work
- Should each department develop their own language relating to use of AI?
- Study impact of AI on workload
  - Survey faculty about their experiences with AI and its impact on workload
- Create structured activities for faculty/students related to AI

# 2. Improved Communication

- Explore use of Slack, Teams, or a similar platform to better communicate between faculty, admin, and students
  - Leverage/promote current tools
- Informing faculty of Ed Code / Legislative Updates
  - Updated list of important laws & bills
  - Create LLM that can explain all the ed code and legislation that impacts faculty via chatbot
  - Identify legislative liaison in Senate
- Facilitating communication & better integrating "otherwise unrepresentated faculty" into the campus
- Exploring options to strengthen representation from KAD

# 3. Textbook Costs / Processes for Materials Adoption

- Create transparency about how ordering works; visible process for faculty
- Clarify options for faculty:
  - OER/ZTC
  - Potential impact of Title V revisions on materials adoption
  - What are the markup prices? Costs for printing OER resources?
    Costs for printing Course Readers?

- Tracking long-term
- Useful for maintaining Math courses?
- Survey faculty on standards
- Share out results with faculty: Flex Day?
- Suggested book: *Cost of Completion* (Robin Isserles)
  - Recommend for Flex Day Speaker?
  - Faculty book club?

#### 5. Reassign Time

- Create more transparency around reassignments
  - Develop process for renewal of and application for faculty reassignments
  - Create webpage under Academic Senate that lists faculty reassignments across college
