APPROVAL OF GUIDED PATHWAYS ACADEMIC AND CAREER COMMUNITIES

Interim Director of Guided Pathways Allie Fasth presented the final version of the Guided Pathways Academic and Career Communities. The communities were developed after consultation with CSM faculty, staff, and students, and reflect the different academic programs at the college. They are intended to outline the pathways that students may follow

to earn a degree or certificate. The Academic and Career Communities will be integrated into the college's outreach, counseling, transfer, and career programs. In addition, the Guided Pathways team will be working to develop an interactive website that will allow students to explore all the different communities. Interim Director Fasth is here to ask the Student Senate to formally bless the Academic and Career Communities.

Motion to approve the Guided Pathways Academic and Career Communities by Senator Noe; seconded by Vice Chair Pellini. Hearing no objections, the motion carried.

GET OUT THE VOTE AND VOTER INFORMATION DRIVE

On behalf of the Advocacy Board, Senator Guanzon shared the Voter Information Presentation. The presentation provides information about the various elected offices and propositions that will be on the November 3 ballot. It also includes details about the Voters' Bill of Rights.

Mr. Hamadeh noted that there are three seats on the San Mateo County Community College District's Board of Trustees that are up for election that were not included in the presentation. Senator Guanzon said that he would information about the candidates. Senator Zamora indicated that today is the final day to register to vote in California and asked if that information would be disseminated. Senator Guanzon said he is working with the Public Relations Board to convert some of the slides from the presentation into social media posts, and that they are planning to make an announcement today about the deadline to register. Mr. Hamadeh pointed out that folks may still register on Election Day (November 3) and receive a provisional ballot. Senator Guanzon also stated that the Advocacy Board is recording a video of the presentation so that students may view it when they have the time.
