DESCRIPTION

The 2022 Active Minds National Conference is held in Washington D.C. from February 11th to February 12 and is the nation’s premier conference focused on young adults and mental health. The conference annually showcases the most innovative and effective approaches to supporting young adult well-being and changing the conversation about mental health on campuses, in workplaces, and within our communities.
