REPORTS

Vice Chair Jane Patelo said that auditions for the World Gala will take place next week. She also reported that the San Mateo Pride Center will have a grand re-opening on March 24 at 12:30 p.m.

Senator Andy Cheng said that the first part of the Women in Leadership Panel would take place this Wednesday, March 15, from 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. in the Bayview Dining Room. There will be food and a panel discussion as part of the event.

Student Life and Leadership Manager Aaron Schaefer asked that Student Senate members support the Women in Leadership Panel event. Mr. Schaefer noted that he has seen an increase in the number of cheating and plagiarism cases come through the College's disciplinary process. He said that professors are aware of A.I. platforms like ChatGPT and are taking steps to address new forms of cheating and plagiarism. Mr. Schaefer said that cheating and plagiarism are taken very seriously at CSM and that students could be putting their academic careers in jeopardy if they are found to have cheated or plagiarized. Finally, Mr. Schaefer said that this is the point in the semester where folks start to drop classes. He said that members of the Senate should speak to himself or Mr. Hamadeh before dropping any of their classes, as the class load has an impact on scholarship availability and their role as student senators. While he and Mr. Hamadeh are not

academic counselors, they can provide perspective and offer suggestions. Before making changes to their schedules, students should always discuss options with their academic counselors.

Student Life and Leadership Assistant Fauzi Hamadeh informed the Student Senate that starting Tuesday, March 14, Public Safety will begin ticketing cars in Lot T without staff parking permits.

Gulnazik Bakhramova announced that the CSM Campus Life and Leadership Award nominations are due tomorrow, March 14, at 4 p.m. She also that CSM will be hosting a Queer Prom for local high schools. CSM students who wish to volunteer at the event will be compensated and should contact the VPSS Office for more information.






