





# Resolution Establishing Pilot Program for the Spring 2023 Semester to Provide Compensation to Students Serving on Participatory Governance Committees

WHEREAS, students fulfill a vital role by participating in the governance process at the College and District level; and

WHEREAS, the California Education Code, Title V, and SMCCCD Board Policy both mandate and encourage the inclusion of students in the governance processes of the College and District; and

WHEREAS, students often must make the choice between working and serving on participatory governance committees while receiving no compensation; and

WHEREAS, faculty, staff, and administrators receive compensation for the time spent on participatory governance committees as part of their regular job duties; and

**WHEREAS**, the District and Foundation have established a pilot program for the Spring 2023 semester that compensates students serving on participatory governance committees \$100.00 per meeting;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Associated Students of CSM does endorse and adopt the student compensation pilot program for any student serving on a participatory governance committee, including hiring committees, for the Spring 2023 semester.
