## REPORTS

Vice President Shive reported that the screening committee for the interim vice president of student services position has recommended Alex Guiriba as the next interim VPSS. The Board of Trustees will be approving Mr. Guiriba's appointment at the September 13, 2023, meeting. Mr. Guiriba is a former CSM student, as well as classified staff member and currently a counselor. He also currently serves as one of the advisors for Katipunan.

Vice Chair Tagashira noted that the Club Fair will take place next Tuesday, September 19, and Wednesday, September 20, from 11 am to 2 pm in the Bayview Dining Room in College Center Building 10. This event will also be an opportunity for ASCSM boards to recruit new members.

Senator Ferreria said that the Cultural Awareness Board will be starting to meet this Wednesday, September 13, from 1 pm to 2 pm.

Dr. Richard Storti, interim CSM president, said that despite the recent changes in leadership, the College is continuing work on many initiatives, including the potential renovation of the Library (Building 9). The District is pursuing funding from the State to help fund upgrades to the building. This follows the relocation of Wellness Services to Building 5 from Building 1, the replacement of the turf on the football field, and the installation of a digital scoreboard at the College Heights Stadium.

Student Life and Leadership Manager Schaefer said that Dr. Joshua Moon-Johnson's going away party will be held Tuesday, September 12, from 2:30 pm to 4 pm in the Center for Global Engagement office (Building 10, Room 390). Mr. Schaefer said that he would be inviting interim Vice President of Student Services Guiriba to a Student Senate meeting. He also reminded anyone connected to a student club or organization to make sure the group's paperwork is submitted ASAP.

Student Life and Leadership Assistant Hamadeh announced that the College's annual Family Science and Astronomy Festival +Makerspace will take place on Saturday, September 30. Activities will take place in Building 36, the Theatre (Building 3), and in various other spots on campus. This is a free event that is open to the community.

## INTRODUCTION AND WELCOME OF CSM INTERIM PRESIDENT

Dr. Richard Stori said that he is excited to be at CSM and that he is looking forward to supporting the ongoing work of the College. Dr. Storti noted that President Ferreira spoke at the College's Opening Day event in August and thanked Vice President Shive for her service on the screening committee for the interim vice president of student services position. President Storti said that he appreciates the contributions of the student leaders and that he values the input of the Student Senate. Dr. Storti said that he looks forward to working with the campus community for as long as he is at CSM.

#### UPDATES ON ENROLLMENT

Dr. Carla Grandy, CSM's vice president of instruction, provided an update on enrollment for the Fall 2023 semester. Compared to last fall, headcount at CSM is up approximately 20%. This is primarily due to the Free College initiative undertaken by the District. Dr. Grandy said that the divisions have been monitoring class enrollments and have added more class sections where necessary. She said that the breakdown between in-person classes and remote/hybrid classes is approximately 50/50. Given this increase in enrollment, Dr. Grandy said that the College is going to need to look at staffing levels for both faculty and classified staff.

#### FUNDING FOR FALL 2023 CLUB FAIR

The Fall 2023 Club Fair will be held on Tuesday, September 19, and Wednesday, September 20, from 11 am to 2 pm in the Bayview Dining Room in College Center Building 10. This will be an opportunity for students to learn about the various clubs and organizations on campus. It will also be a chance for the ASCSM boards to recruit new members. To

encourage students to visit club tables, Inter Club Council is requesting funding for food. In addition, the clubs have requested funds to purchase candy to distribute from their tables.

Motion to approve \$3,500.00 from the Club Account Reserve trust account to support the Fall 2023 Club Fair by Senator Teng, seconded by Senator Cheng. The motion was carried with all members present voting in favor.
