  - a. **Officers**

President Kaffl stated that Senator Zhang is to be appointed to the Accreditation Oversight Committee.

Motion to approve Senator Zhang to the Accreditation Oversight Committee by Vice Chair Roe; seconded by Senator Jacky Wong. Without objection, the motion passes.

**c. Phi Theta Kappa Regional Conference Funding - PTK**

PTK president Carlos stated that they will be having a regional conference in Las Vegas and this time they will only have eight people going. This trip will help students get more leadership experience and improve their leadership skills

Motion to approve \$2,400 to PTK Regional Conference Funds by Senator Ferroggiaro; seconded by Senator Kim.

President stated that they only request money for flight tickets and what about the other costs. Carlos stated that the club account money will cover the rest.

Vice President Trump asked have they attended this conference before. Carlos stated that last time it was only him and one other person went.

Senator Mascareno asked the price of the tickets and Carlos stated that they looked it up it was 300 for each person.

Advisor Schaefer stated that this proposal could pass but if he found out that they had already booked the ticket he won't release the funds.

With a vote of 13 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining, the motion carries.

**d. Cesar Chavez Community Garden Funding - Botany Club**

Botany Club representatives stated that on March 24 which is the Cesar Chavez Week they will be planting various types of plants at the outside of the library. This is a community event and it will make our campus look nicer which is important for our school as a Bee campus. They stated that the graduation ceremony will also be held there so it will be nicer with more plants.

Motion to approve \$800.00 for CSM Cesar Chavez Community Garden by Senator Zhang; second by Senator Hamzah.

Senator Stein asked can the farm plants grow well at outside and representative stated that they can.

Senator Ferroggiaro asked if the Facilities Department signed off and will they maintain them.

Representative stated that Facilities had signed off but will need more water to maintain different plants.

With a vote of 13 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining, the motion carries.

**e. Get Your Laugh On Event Funding - Professor Rudy Ramirez**

Professor Rudy stated that there will be six comedians who will bring nice diverse view of politics, race and society issues. He wants to offer this opportunity to CSM students.

Motion to approve \$1400.00 for Get Your Laugh On Event by Senator Stein; second by Senator Ferroggiaro.

Senator Ferroggiaro asked is this stand-up and Rudy stated this is a stand-up comedy and all six comedians are professional. Senator Ferroggiaro asked why 1400 dollars and Rudy stated that \$300 for comedians, \$400 for snacks and \$700 for videographer.

Senator Stein asked the time and Rudy stated that it will be at the theater from 7:30 pm to 9:00 pm on April 27.

With a vote of 13 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining, the motion carries.

**f. WTFilm Student Film Festival Funding - Programming Board Chair Stein**

Senator Stein stated that this event will be similar to the one last semester and each category will have one winner which gets a \$500 check. There will also be an award for students to choose their favorite firm and the winner will also get \$500. The deadline will be April 26 and the award ceremony will be on either May 11, 12 or 13. She also stated that total cost will increase \$500 because they have to pay the faculties.

Motion to approve \$3300 for What the Firm Festival by Senator Jacky Wong; second by Senator Elkady.

Senator Ferroggiaro asked why they put it in the building 10. Senator Stein stated that there will be more viewers and attendees and also they can provide food there while it's forbidden in the theater.

Senator Jacky Wong asked if senators can attend. Advisor Schaefer Stated that senators can help but only the senators and executive cabinet officers can't get money.

Senator Mascareno asked have they decided who are the judge professors. Senator Stein stated that it hasn't been decided yet.

President Kaffl asked how many films had been submitted last time. Advisor Schaefer stated that they had four to six movies per categories and people had put lots of effort into it so that's why they set the award at \$500 for each.

With a vote of 13 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining, the motion carries.

**g. Event for Evening Students - Programming Board Chair Stein**

Senator Stein stated that she will discuss with Advisor Schaefer about the date of the event and email to everyone tonight. She also stated that everyone should also check their junk inbox because some sign-up emails might be categorized there. Senator Jacky Wong stated that last semester they ended up with lots of food left so this time we should buy more food on the first day. Advisor Schaefer stated that Jacky means buy 70% of the food on the first day and see how much left and how much more food will be needed on the second day.

Senator Vina Wong asked the time and Senator Stein stated that it will start at 4:30 and end around 6:30.

President Kaffl stated that last time there were some lights issues so this time we need to make sure the lights are on to make our event look very awesome.


