STUDENT TRUSTEE NOMINEE ELECTION

As per Article I, Section 13, Item 13.6.b of the ASCSM Bylaws, a minimum of fifty (50) votes must be cast in the Student Trustee Nominee Election in order for the election to be considered valid. If the election is not deemed valid, the candidates must be forwarded to the Student Senate, who shall select a nominee.

In the Spring 2019 Student Trustee Nominee Election, polls were open Tuesday, March 26, 2019, and Wednesday, March 27, 2019. There was one (1) candidate, Jordan Chavez. A total of twenty-five (25) votes were cast.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Student Senate interview the candidate for Student Trustee Nominee and then hold a vote to determine if they will be forwarded to the District Student Council as the nominee from CSM.
