REPORTS

President Young congratulated members on being elected to the 2019-20 ASCSM Senate. He praised the Senate for their dedication throughout the elections, noting that it could be difficult to put oneself out there. Mr. Young expressed his gratitude for everyone's presence, and stated that he was happy to see new faces.

Vice President Gaines also congratulated members of the Senate on their new positions and indicated that he was excited to see the group grow together.

Secretary Chavez encouraged members to step out of their comfort zones throughout their terms to get the most out of the ASCSM experience.

Student Life and Leadership Manager Schaefer expressed his excitement over the amount of members who were new to ASCSM. Mr. Schaefer went over his and Mr. Hamadeh's roles as advisors, noting that, they were solely there to help guide the Senate and not to conduct their activities and events for them. Advisor Schaefer remarked that, as the year progressed, meetings would entail shorter advisor reports. He then told the Senate that the retreat at the end of the summer would be an opportunity for students to get to know one another better, learn skills on leadership, conflict resolution, and communication. Mr. Schaefer encouraged members to bond with each other, take classes together, and get to know one

another beyond their Senate duties. Regarding the limited number of absences allowed for a member's term, Advisor Schaefer reminded the Senate that they should only use their absences for dire situations such as illness, as attendance is important for quorum to be met. Mr. Schaefer indicated that it was vital for the group to begin business during the summer. He also reminded the Senate that, as advisors, both he and Mr. Hamadeh were available for support beyond ASCSM duties.

Student Life and Leadership Assistant Hamadeh brought up several housekeeping issues, urging members to check their emails regularly. Mr. Hamadeh stated that keys to the Senate Office in Building 12 would be provided for a \$20.00 deposit; lockers would also be assigned if members checked in with Advisor Hamadeh. Mr. Hamadeh told the Senate the office would be available during normal college operating hours, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
