

CSM Degrees and Certificates by Varsity Athletics

Fall 2009 to Summer 2014 (15 Terms)



Data Included:

- Table A: *CSM Associate Degrees by Varsity Athletic Experience*
- Table B: *CSM Degrees and Certificates by Varsity Athletic Experience by Academic Year*
- Tables contain data spanning 15 terms, Fall 2009 – Summer 2014. For comparative purposes Table A includes the representation of students participating in any intercollegiate sport as proportion of the total CSM student population. Findings, included below, are conclusions based upon this 15-term period.
- Student athletes considered in this analysis were participants in the following sports. Men's: baseball, cross-country, football, swimming, track & field. Women's: basketball, cross-country, softball, swimming, track & field, water polo.

Key Findings:

- A total of 5,590 Degrees and Certificates were awarded, Fall 2009 – Summer 2014. Student athletes participating in all intercollegiate athletics earned 10.4% of all Associate Degrees (n=252). Correspondingly, participants in intercollegiate sport comprise only 3.7% of the total student population in Fall 2013. (See Table A)
- Table B presents the number and percent of all awards (Associate Degrees, Certificates, and Associate Degree + Certificates) earned by intercollegiate athletic participants as a proportion of all college awards.
