

# *Profile of CSM Student Athlete Transfers*

## 2013/14

### **Key Findings:**

- In the academic year 2013/14, 53 CSM student athletes transferred to 4-year colleges and universities.
- This number (53) represents a 64% transfer rate for all intercollegiate athletes completing their 2<sup>nd</sup> year of eligibility at CSM. (*CCCCAA Student Athlete Eligibility Report, 2013-2014*) The most ethnically diverse intercollegiate sport, football, registered a transfer rate of 89%. In contrast, the Collegewide transfer rate for the 2010-2013 Student-Right-to-Know cohort is 21%.
- African American student athletes comprise 26.4% of all intercollegiate athletic transfers. Pacific Islanders represent 24.5% of transfers.
- This report reveals the large number of students of color not tracked by official databases. The only consistent and official transfer data reports provided to California Community Colleges are limited to tracking transfers enrolling at UC and CSU, only. In contrast, this report tracks CSM student athletes transferring not only to UC and CSU, but also to California private colleges and universities, and to out-of-state and Canadian institutions.
  - For example, while the CSU and UC Systemwide offices report only 4 African American transfers to CSU and 4 African American transfer to UC in 2012/13, respectively, this report reveals an additional 14 African American student athletes who transferred to out-of-state or California private colleges.
