

We're Hiring Sheriff's Summer Intern

The San Mateo County Sheriff's Office is looking for up to 13 summer interns to perform a variety of administrative functions in divisions throughout the Sheriff's Office. Participants in the 2023 Sheriff's Summer Internship Program will be expected to commit to the entire 12-week program from June 5 – August 25, 2023.

Each intern will work a maximum of 20 hours a week earning \$19.17/hr. Typical work hours will be Monday through Friday 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. with flexibility to be further discussed during the placement portion of the hiring process.

Requirements

- Must be eligible to work in the United States.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must possess a high school diploma or educational equivalent.
- Must successfully pass a thorough background investigation prior to employment. Interns assigned to the Crime Lab, Corrections Facility and assigned to work with youth will be required medical clearance.
