Craft


- Understand the fundamentals of visual, user experience, and interaction design, so that you can bring it into your work (professionally and personally).

- Refine and practice your creative problem-solving process and apply it to real-world projects.


Communication and Intentionality


- Present a point-of-view on your work and how you arrived there with your decision-making (the "why") and creative process.
- Learn how to provide constructive critiques on group work and how to receive critique on their own work.
- Develop and give presentations to an audience to develop your communication skills such as storytelling and the art of persuasion.

Proactivity and Drive

- As a group lead, take ownership of the project(s) and learn to develop proactive problem-solving.
- Learn time & project management while developing ways of sharing out progress and priorities for optimized collaboration.

- Be a current or recent student (AY 2021, 2022, 2023) age 18+ and a Bay Area resident during the duration of the UX Design Apprenticeship

- Attend an in-person interview at 95 Washington
 Street in Oakland (may take up to two hours)
- Commit to and fully participate in the UX Design Apprenticeship (takes place in-person from June 6 through August 31, 2023)
