- Debrief:
 - Research is all over the place – need more support on how to structure research questions
 - No linkage to SLOs
 - Broad & subjective terms – “poor”, “helpful”, “critical thinking”
 - If we already know the answer (struggles in certain areas), can we test out new methods intentionally
 - “Yes/No” is not always helpful
- New form for this year. Future revision: new spot for feedback
- Methods
 - So many folks go to “survey”
 - Emphasis to have faculty get assistance from PRIE
 - Professional development workshop on how to make surveys
 - PD on making surveys, or PD on creating questions?
 - Series of workshops - “clinics”
 - Show progression of questions as an example, share success stories
 - Questions that could be scaled up to entire college
 - AB 705
 - Communication
 - Source evaluation
