#### Abstract

ASSIST.org and the CSM Catalog identify courses required for your MAJOR. +There are instances when a CSM course is approved for IGETC but the same course at SKYLINE or CANADA IS NOT approved for IGETC. Use ASSIST to confirm course articulation! +If you completed course work outside of CSM, CAÑADA, or SKYLINE submit a TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION REQUEST FORM on WebSMART.
