- Services:
 - Dedicated staff
 - Paola is the main contact to refer students to primary undocuLiason
 - Counselor
 - Partnership through immigration legal services project
 - 3 times a week, students can talk with a legal provider
 - Scholar internship program
 - Scholarship guide
 - Direct Services:
 - Book, supplies, case management
- Gaps in services:
 - Non resident tuition waiver for students in 6 units
 - Mental health support
 - Emergency funds and direct aid to students with highest need (non-DACA, non-AB540 eligible)
 - Expanding professional development support and student leadership
- How GP can support the highest need student population (who don't qualify for DACA or AB 540) since a lot of the students affected are ESL students.

General updates:

ESL Backwards mapping project:

- Emily's working on a doc that outlines recommended courses that ESL students can take in the first semester according to their ESL levels. Will share in a couple of weeks.

Program mapper timeline:
