# CLUSTER UPDATE

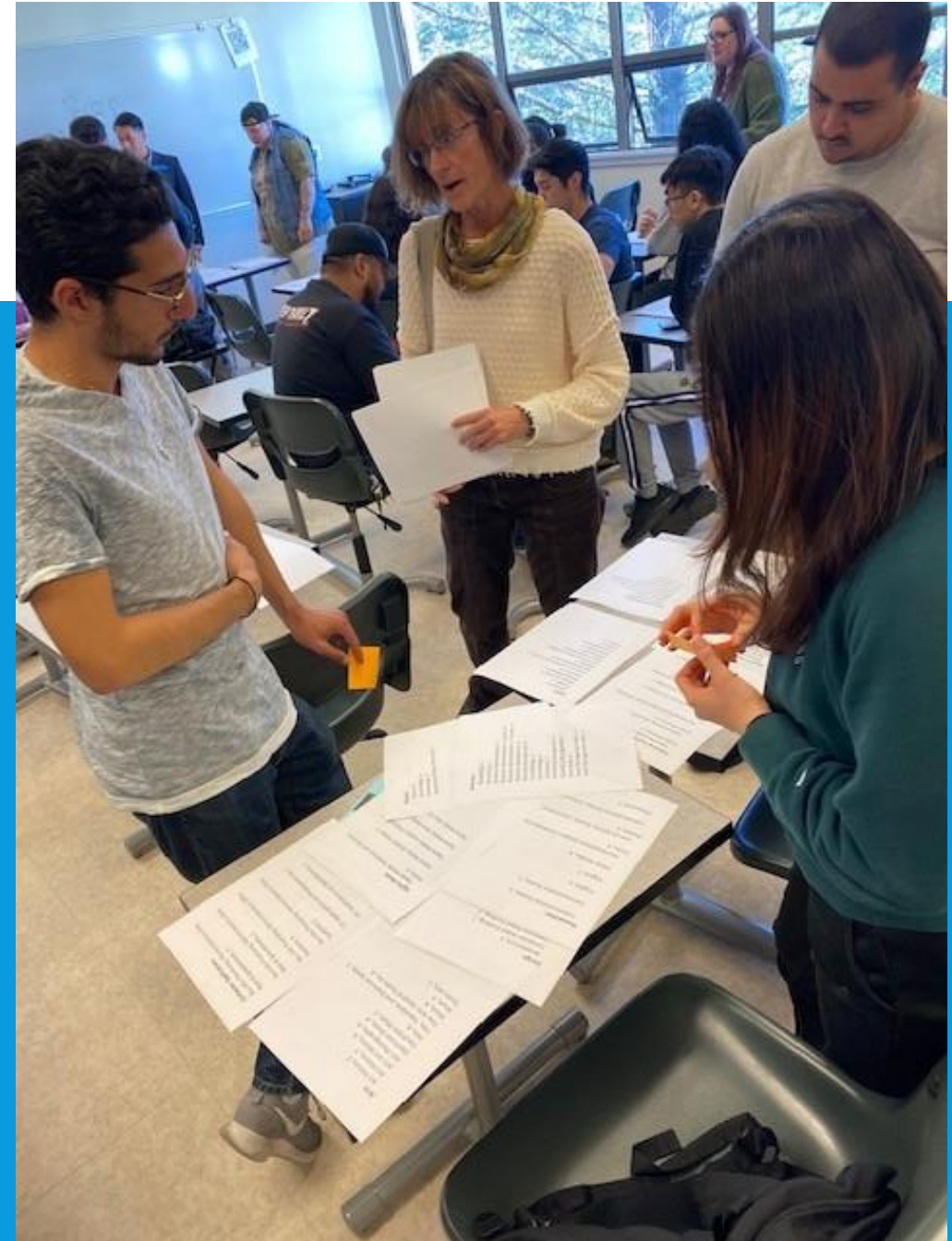
What are clusters?
