



Library Services Platform (LSP)

- Transition of library catalog and online resources to a common software system- January 2020
- All three SMCCD campuses adopted
- 116 California community colleges, all CSUs, and most UCs joined
- Better linking to electronic resources, increased access, increased equity









Important updates - Fall 2020

- \$440K grant given to California community colleges from Academic Senate for California Community Colleges
- Amounts to an 18% reduction in operating costs for the project for the next year








Impact of LSP on our Community

Impact of LSP on the Campus


- Improved workflow for staff on the ground
