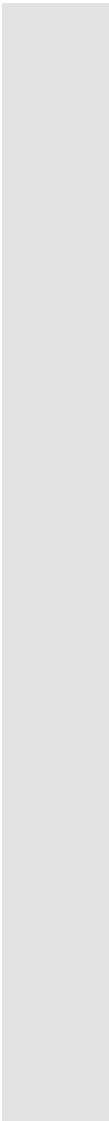

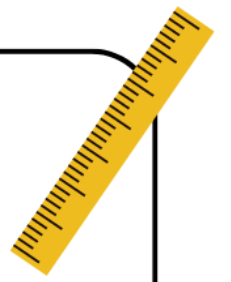

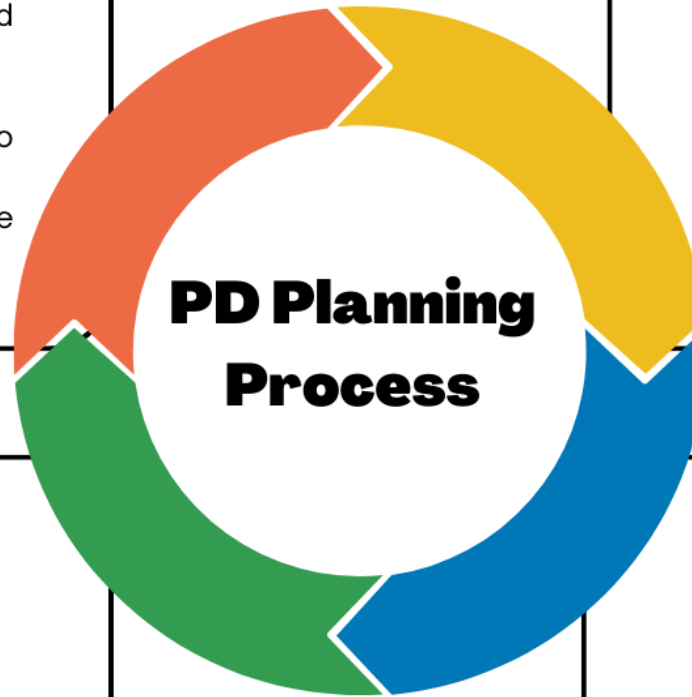
## Define
