- All applicants are required to watch and complete <u>mandatory information workshop</u> in order to be eligible to apply. Video and quiz are posted on the CSM Nursing website at <u>http://collegeofsanmateo.edu/nursing/</u> and it will be available during in <u>fall semester</u>. Online workshop quiz must have a minimum score <u>16 or</u> <u>higher</u>. Please resubmit quiz until you have a passing score.
- Fall 2024 applications will be submitted online to College of San Mateo Nursing (Non-fee application). Information will be available in late Fall (December 1, 2023).
- If an applicant plans to fulfill a prerequisite course with an AP/Honors Course score (3 or higher), a <u>Prerequisite Eval</u> form must be filled out and sent to Marsha Ramezane at <u>ramezane@smccd.edu</u>. An approval by the transcript evaluator for AP/Honors Course is required.
