STUDENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

DEFINITION and GOAL:

The Student Advisory Committee is an ongoing, active committee consisting of students and faculty who meet to review program policies and discuss course concerns. The goal of the committee is to provide an avenue for student input into the program.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

This committee meets monthly to:

- 1. Two elected representatives from each class,
- 2. An officer of the Nursing Students' Association may attend.
- 3. The Nursing Director and the Assistant Nursing Director.
