Displays comparative demographic aggregated retention and success data. Data combine all Fall semesters.

### Enrollments

Indicates a duplicated headcount that is the sum of end-of-term enrollments.

#### % Retention

The percentage of enrollments with a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, at endof-term (only excludes W's).

#### % Success

Also known as "successful course completion." The percentage of enrollments with a grade of A, B, C, or P at end-of-term.
