Displays summary data of total enrollment, numbers of sections offered, retention, and success.

##### Part II: Demographic Profile

Displays comparative demographic data aggregated with retention and success data. This includes totals for all Fall semesters combined.

##### Enrollments

Indicates a duplicated headcount that is the sum of end-of-term enrollments.

##### Retention %

The percentage of enrollments with a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, at end-of-term (only excludes W's).

##### Success %

Also known as "successful course completion." The percentage of enrollments with a grade of A, B, C, or P at end-of-term.
