IPC also develops and assesses progress on strategic priorities, identifies and assesses institutional initiatives, and ensures that the participatory governance process is properly followed across all participatory governance committees. All four constituencies are represented on IPC. Thus, IPC serves as a conduit and "clearinghouse" for institutional planning for all constituency groups.
