Minutes

Violent Intruder Drill

- Target date to be determined; suggested for the first couple of weeks in October.
- Gerardo Ramirez to request Cabinet assistance in identifying open times while avoiding conflicts with midterms, recruiting events, college-wide events, and board meeting nights.

Great Shake Out (GSO)

- Scheduled for Tuesday, October 14, 2025, at 10:14 AM.
- Ben Zara emphasized connecting more closely with Building Captains via newsletter and training them in preparation for GSO.
- Public Information Officer (PIO) to send an announcement to campus email 3–4 days prior to drill; RAVE alert will be sent the morning of the event.
- Safety tip for GSO: individuals should move 1.5 times the distance of the nearest building's height.

Skyline Campus Power Outage Review

- In case of a power outage, college leadership texts the Crisis Action Team (CAT) group, triggering PIO to send awareness messages.
- CAT reviews the PG&E website, contacts PG&E if necessary, and determines whether to close campus.
- Concerns raised regarding decision timelines for canceling classes, especially for short outages.
- Considerations for closure decisions may need to be building-specific (lighting, ventilation, program requirements).
- Campus community has expressed frustration over closures when power is restored quickly.
- o In power outages, the Planetarium goes completely dark; emergency lighting is available for 90 minutes to 4 hours.

Building Captain Picnic

- Recognition event for Building Captains, providing resources and light educational content.
- Opportunity to reinforce knowledge of drills (GSO, Violent Intruder Drill, fire drills) and address Building Captains' requests for role clarity.
- Consider establishing once-a-semester Building Captain gatherings for engagement.

- o 10:30 AM -event setup.
- o 11:00 AM –lawn games, and social time.
- o **12:00–1:00 PM** Lunch for Building Captains and Safety Committee members.
- 1:00 PM –one hour of skills and knowledge review with Ben Zara and Vince Garcia.
- Potential skills demo (e.g., Narcan use). No burn-pan demonstration due to logistics.
- o Consider late picnic start to accommodate Student Services event.
